May 7, 2013

The meeting was called to order by Milton Campo at 7:05 PM.

Motion made by Ed Drechsel to approve April 2013 meeting minutes, and second motion made by

Debbie Kelly. **Motion passed**.

New Business:

Church Ministries: Sandy Matteson addressed members as a representative of the Liturgical committee to ask help in recruiting persons for ministries that were losing persons; searching for new members as well as persons to chair committees.

3rd **Quarter Financial Summary & Budget Proposal:** Sylvester McClellan and Debbie Knarr presented financial update with a written copy of the actual current Budget and the proposed budget for next fiscal year. At this time last year, a committee was put in place to look for ways to cut expenses to help balance the budget since we were approximately \$50k in the red; but today, Sylvester was pleased to say that the budget at 3rd Quarter is in the black by about \$30k. He reviews the budget very closely every quarter with the Finance Council in order to alert Father and the Parish Council if any problems appear so that appropriate implementations could be set in motion to avoid going backwards. Some of the reason is the changes in membership and an increase in parish collections; and suggestions made by the committee to control expenses. He also presented a list of improvement projects that the Parish needs to have done, but are not part of the proposed Budget.

After questions and discussion, Debbie Kelly moved to approve the proposed budget for the next fiscal year as presented by Sylvester. This was seconded by Nan Nichols. **Motion passed.**

Elections results: Debbie Kelly thanked the help from Milton and Ed and announced that after a very close election of 6 very capable persons, the newly elected members to the Parish Council are Mark Molnar, Rita Guest, Elizabeth Martin, and Mary Ann Cronin. Milton recognized two of the newly elected members that were present and were congratulated; and all the new members will be welcomed to the next meeting in June.

Slate of Officers: Milton Campo announced that those willing to serve as officers on next year's Parish Council are as follows: Chair, Debbie Kelly; Co-Chair, Brian McGovern; Scribe, Nan Nichols. Tom Trudeau moved to approve the proposed slate of officers. Larry seconded the motion. **Motion passed.**

Ongoing Business:

Parish Neighborhoods: Tom Trudeau announced that this project was now back on track. The directories were being updated with new addresses. Ann Martin was updating parishioners to her data base that includes the family names. Once he gets the updated listing then he will meet with Sandy Matteson who will take over this project. There are 30 neighborhoods with 5-18 households. There will be a selection of about 3 neighborhoods to start with that will have about 8-10 households. There is an announcement ready to go the Parishioners once the project is ready to go; the hope is to place it next month. He also updated the new membership with this neighborhood ministry project which follows the Corporal works of mercy and improvement of communication—this is not intended to replace small Christian communities.

Other Discussion:

Milton updates the Council with a newly formed Welcome committee: with attempts to make visitors feel welcome, Milton Campo, Mary Ann Cronin, Ed Monfalcone, and Catherine Hucabee were working on improvements to accomplish this, i.e. a Greeters program. Father also mentioned that he plans to start inviting visitors to stand to be recognized during the Masses as well.

Father Jim mentioned that the Bishop was promoting a new Capital Campaign for Diocesan needs. He is meeting with a Diocesan representative and fund-raising official in the Social Hall May 8th from 2:00-2:30PM if anyone is interested in attending.

The improvement work is still being done on the sanctuary; to be completed soon.
