Inquiry and study of Catholic tradition and doctrine lead to full participation through the Sacraments of Initiation and reflection on the depth of God's love revealed in the Paschal Mystery.

Today Bishop Knestout suspended all public Masses in the Diocese until further notice.

All non-essential meetings at the church are cancelled.

Our church is open Monday through Thursday 9:00 to 2:00 and Friday 9:00 to 1:00 and on Sunday morning from 9:00 until noon, for private prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, which is in the tabernacle on our main altar. The daily Mass chapel, however, is closed until further notice. Please understand that, per the instructions of the Bishop, no more than 10 people can be in our church at one time.

Let us pray for healing for those who have contracted the coronavirus, for protection for caregivers, and for an end to this pandemic. As God's sons and daughters, we draw close to the Lord and remember Jesus' constant refrain in the Gospels, "Do not be afraid".
