# LITNIC LITURGY PICNICS

During Father Gregory's first summer here in 2019, he introduced a new summertime event at St. Therese-- It is the <u>litnic</u>. Litnics are Liturgy picnics, and here's how they work. Someone who wants to host a litnic calls the parish office and signs up for one of the posted available dates. They receive <u>parish guidelines</u> for hosting a litnic which must be read carefully. Litnics are particularly intended for Catholics in the host's neighborhood, but all parishioners are invited to litnics. A Mass is celebrated in the home or the yard (the *lit*) followed by a potluck supper (the *nic*). A suggested time for a Litnic would be 6:30, but that would be up to the host. # **NEW MASS GUIDELINES**

The Diocese has put out new guidelines based on the Governor's Executive Order 79. The following applies to all those coming to the church for a meeting or Mass.

- a. All fully vaccinated individuals may forego wearing masks inside or outside on church property. It is their choice whether to wear a mask or not.
- b. All unvaccinated individuals, including children from ages 5-12, MUST still wear masks.

In addition, the Bishop has lifted the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation and reinstating that obligation begins on Saturday, June 26, 2021 and Sunday, June 27, 2021.
