# LITNIC LITURGY PICNICS

During Father Gregory's first summer here in 2019, he introduced a new summertime event at St. Therese-- It is the <u>litnic</u>. Litnics are Liturgy picnics, and here's how they work. Someone who wants to host a litnic calls the parish office and signs up for one of the posted available dates. They receive <u>parish guidelines</u> for hosting a litnic which must be read carefully. Litnics are particularly intended for Catholics in the host's neighborhood, but all parishioners are invited to litnics. A Mass is celebrated in the home or the yard (the *lit*) followed by a potluck supper (the *nic*). A suggested time for a Litnic would be 6:30, but that would be up to the host.
