SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

As Christians, we are called to share in Christ's life and sacrifice. On this Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known as Corpus Christi, we delve into Christ's willingness to sacrifice Himself for others. God becoming human in Christ was the beginning of a life devoted to others. God is always attentive to our needs and is ready to provide what is best

for us. Jesus is the fullness of God's gift to us. Feeding on Christ, bonds us to Christ – God – and one another, and all of creation. Such bonding calls us to nourish others the way God nourishes us in Christ. God gifts us with "the best of wheat (Ps 147:14). He knows what is best for us and sends us nothing but the best. Christ, our Living Bread, is the best gift that God has ever given. Our response is one or great joy and thankfulness, the essence of our Eucharistic celebrations. To feed on Christ, our Living Bread, means nor only being bonded to Christ and one another at Eucharist but we must also be willing to bring our Living Bread to the streets. If we become what we eat, then every aspect of ou lives should reflect that. Everyone we interact with should know who has fed and nourished us.




