LITNIC SEASON HAS BEGUN AT ST. THERESE! Litnics are Liturgy picnics, and here's how they work. Someone who wants to host a Litnic calls the parish office and signs up for one of the posted available dates. They receive parish guidelines for hosting a Litnic which must be read carefully. Litnics are particularly intended for Catholics in the host's neighborhood, but all parishioners are invited to Litnics. A Mass is celebrated in the home or the yard (the lit) followed by a potluck supper (the nic). A suggested time for a Litnic would be 6:30 p.m., but that would be up to the host.

Please RSVP at our phone number (540) 841-0736 or email jawalkeriii@aol. com. All are encouraged to bring a comfortable outdoor chair if you have one, and swimwear and a towel if you'd like to swim. Attendees may find our home by using a map service such as Google maps or Apple maps, or by following these directions: at the intersection of Dutton Road (Rt 198) and Harcum Road (Rt 606), proceed on Harcum Road toward the Piankatank river. After about 0.9 miles, turn left onto Deep Point Lane. After about 0.2 miles, continue straight onto the gravel road which is River Crest Drive (Note: speed limit on River Crest Dive is 15 miles per hour.) After about 0.3 miles, turn left onto the driveway for 11694. Follow the signs for about 0.2 miles to reach the home."

BAPTISMAL PREPARATION



Because of that, I was able to give a very generous donation to 3 ministries which support Catholic young people going on mission to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ: 1) CEM-POC [Catholic Evangelical Missionary People of Color Grant Inc.] which hopes to provide financial assistance to missionaries who are actively serving in Catholic Ministry and who identify as People of Color or belonging to an ethnic minority, 2) the permanent mission of the Missioners of Christ in Comayagua, Honduras, from which we were sent to El Salvador, and 3) Saint Paul's Outreach, a Catholic movement that builds dynamic communities of deep relationship that witness to the Gospel on college campuses and beyond. The 9 young adults for whom I was chaplain to El Salvador were from St. Paul's Outreach.


