### SAINT THERESE FINANCIAL SUMMARY

July 2023- June 2024

This memo provides information on the financial position of St. Therese for the first quarter (6 months) of the Fiscal Year.

This Statement of Operating Income depicts a net **loss** from operations of **\$34,251.67**. The church has unrealized **gains** from investments and the endowment fund of **\$21,792.26** which cannot be spent without diminishing the principal (selling investments).

We continue to see a rise in online giving platforms with now **35%** of the parish giving **electronically**. Of the **568** registered households at the parish, **479** of them give via some form of registered giving, with **8%** contributing to **loose cash or not contributing**. This information also indicates that the majority of our income is from Regular Contributions and Special Designated Donations. Many thanks also to parishioners who continue to donate to the Endowment Fund.

In addition, donations to the endowment are on track to fund the spending plan which allows for the use of interest income above the amount of the spending plan threshold. The generosity of the parish has enabled us to establish this fund which will allow a future income stream for the parish.

Operating expenses this quarter reflect our Diocesan Mandates/Overhead. Utility reductions have helped offset lower overall income.

The church staff has always maintained meticulous records and demonstrated exemplary fiduciary responsibility with our donations during these difficult economic times. In accordance with Father Gregory's direction, only necessary expenditures are currently funded.

We appreciate your generosity and ask that you continue to support Saint Therese with your time, talent and treasure.

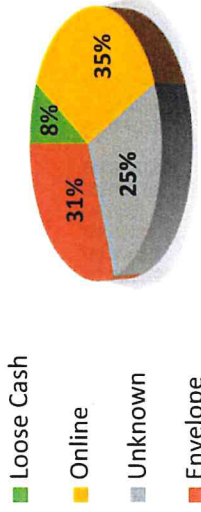

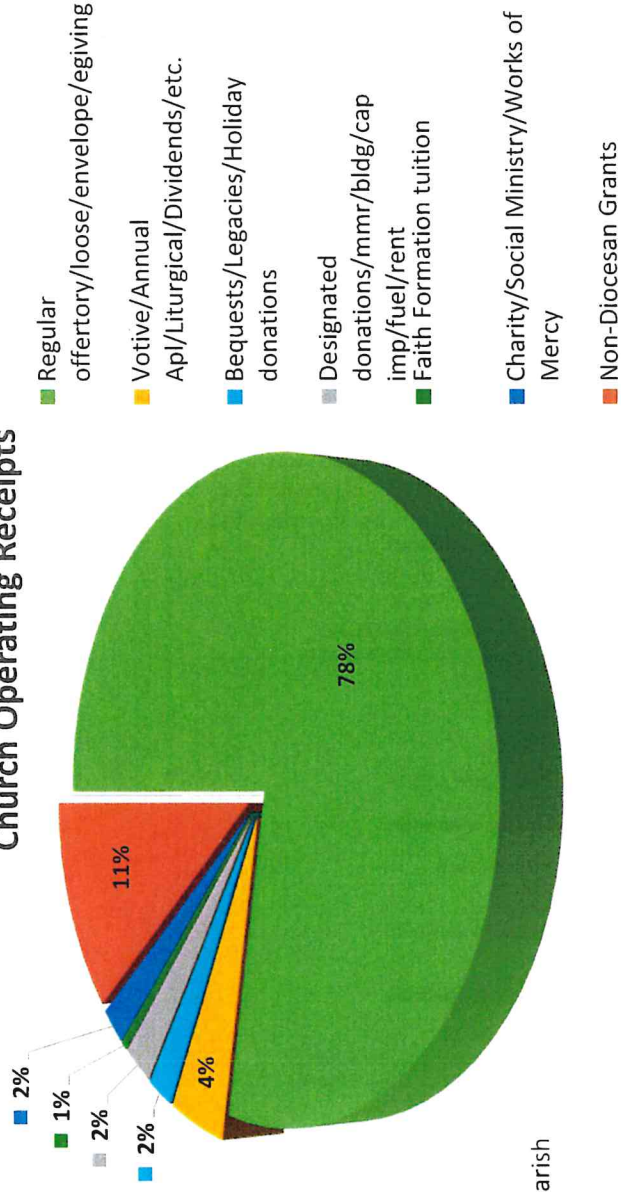

## Givers by Type

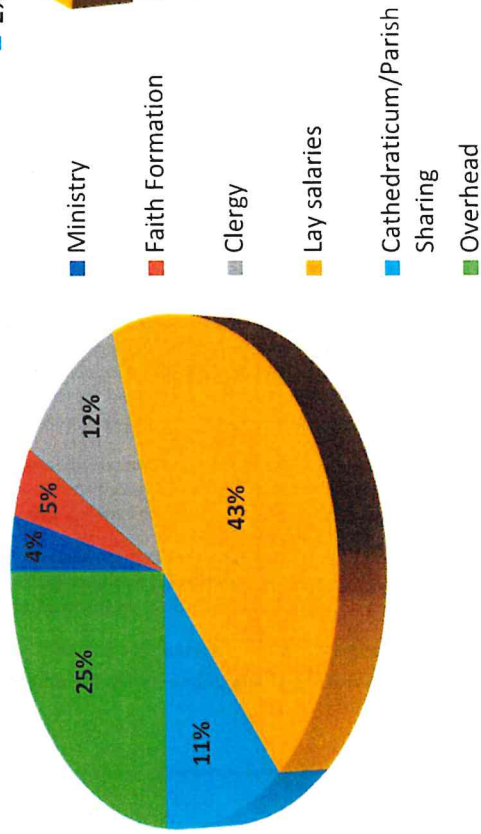

**Mass Times for Fridays during Lent:** Please take note. On Fridays during Lent, that is, from February 16 through March 22 inclusive, Friday Mass will be at 10:00 a.m., NOT noon.

### LENTEN FAST & ABSTINENCE

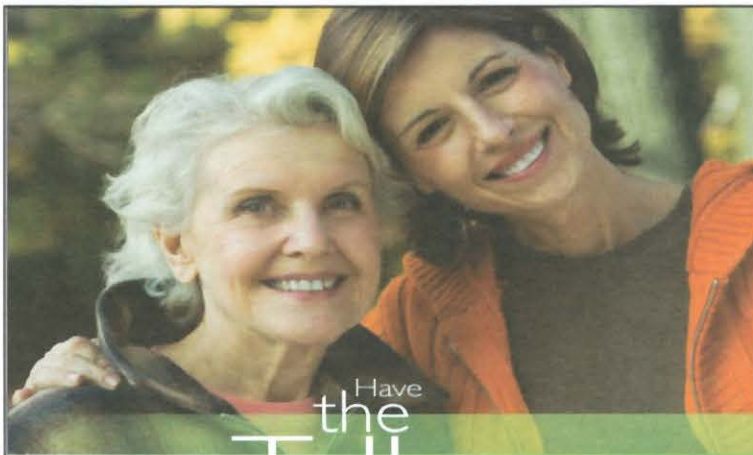
The regulations on Lenten fast and abstinence are:

**Fasting:** On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, those who are 18 but not yet 60 are allowed only one full meal. Two smaller meals are allowed as needed, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

**Abstinence from meat:** Those who are 14 years of age or older are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

The Church no longer attempts to prescribe Lenten practices in detail. The above regulations simply highlight Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the other Fridays of Lent. The more fundamental obligation is to make Lent a penitential season, choosing practices that are adapted to one's own circumstances.
