June 4, 14, 28, July 10, 16, 23, August 23, 29

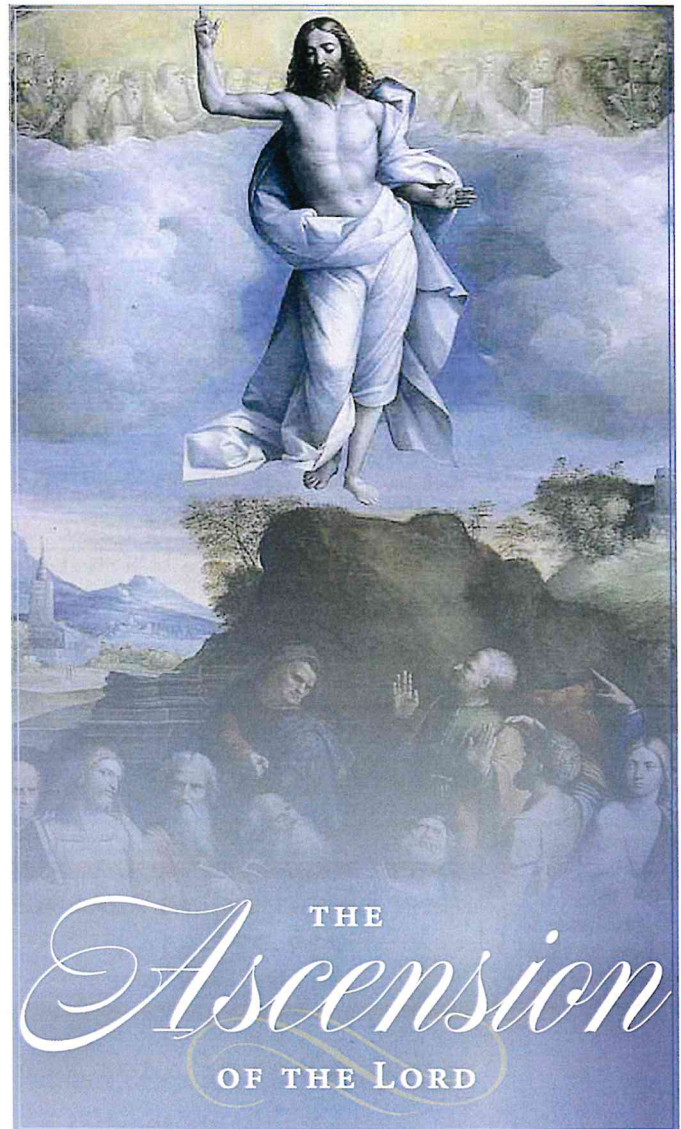
