COME TO THE TABLE VBS

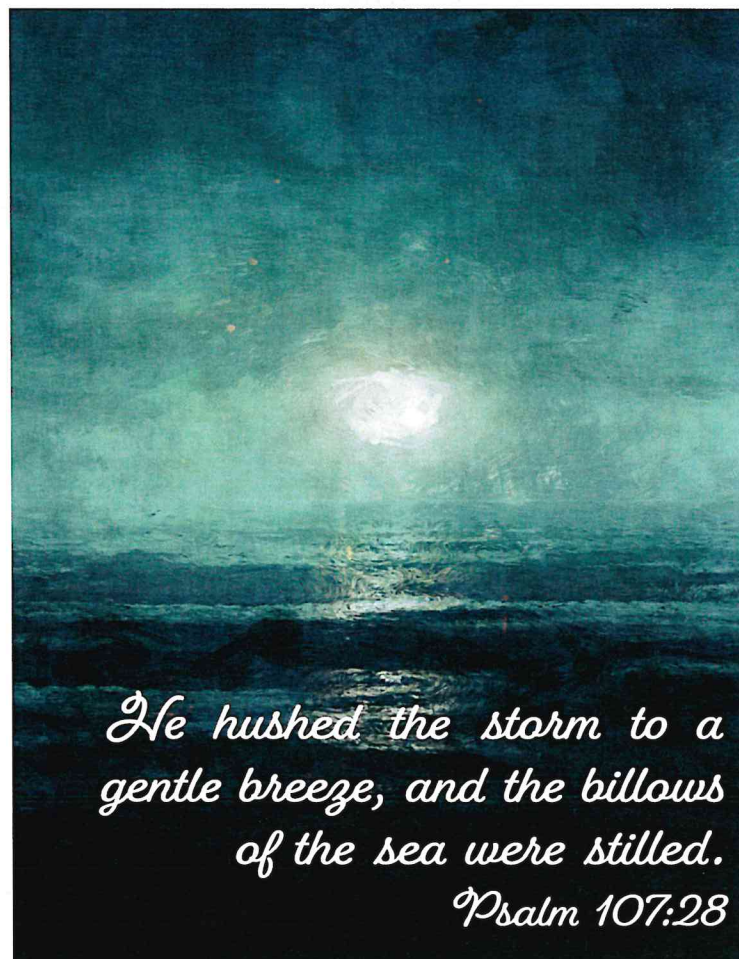
