Meeting: Friday September 6th, 2024 @ 10am *Items in italics are CORRECTIONS of the original Minutes text

Welcome: The meeting was called to order at 10: am after people got breakfast.

President, Jan D. Opening prayer: Jan recited Ann's submitted prayer: God's Garden.

Funeral Reception Coordinator, Marianne M.: Funeral report: No funerals for June, July or August but one already scheduled for September.

Old Business:

June Minutes: The June Minutes were approved as presented.

Fathers' Day Breakfast: Coordinator: Linda G.: Approx 50 people. Approx \$90. 11 donations of food. Breakfast casseroles, 8 pkj. of sausage links, 4 pkj. of bacon, 2 bowls of fruit. Thank you to the many volunteers who helped.

New Ministry: The Meal Train Ministry was discussed and it was agreed that procedures will be set for people and families that are in need. Beverly is the coordinator. She needs a co-coordinator to work with her so that if Beverly is not available, the co-coordinator can smoothly take charge. Beverly thinks it will be ready to trial run in October.

Someone (probably a friend, neighbor or family member) will be first to communicate with the family to determine if the family even wants or needs the help. Those referrals will be forwarded to Beverly. The coordinator will make the decisions. When Meal Train is needed, Beverly will send the link out to the Meal Train Volunteer List and those volunteers will individually link to Meal Train and sign up based on the needs. Once ready to be fully running, The Meal Train Ministry will be advertised in the bulletin and on the website. Similar to Funeral Reception Ministry, this will be a separate and independent ministry under the Theresian Society umbrella.

[from Beverly: Note for this week's meeting; Meal Train full startup will be slightly delayed. Instead, I plan to do a soft start with referrals from Theresians for people who are recovering from an illness/injury/hospitalization that could use a few good home cooked meals. This will allow me time to work out any kinks in organizing this program.]

Church of St Therese 85th **Anniversary and Parish Picnic:** Events asked us to provide the main dessert. [Linda C. ordered the Cupcake Cake and extra cupcakes. Jan picked them up and the Theresians paid for them. The Cupcake Cake was STUNNING!]

New Business:

Discussion to review and update, particularly items that need approval and vetting for situations. Officer Job descriptions and responsibilities need some clarification. Last updates were made in 2018. Jan, Marge, Margie and Teresa will be the committee but all input is welcome. There are By Laws copies (in our mail box).

OctoberFEST 2024: Saturday, October 19th (after Mass) Theresians will provide Brats & buns and Kraut (+ burgers & dogs & buns left from parish picnic). Asking the Parish to help with German themed or inspired sides and desserts. We have a decorating team (Ann, Beverly, Donna) [There were LOTS of Fall decorating items stored in the garage but I don't know which group "owns" them—it might even be us.] & we have the Hall on Friday if they need a head start. We'll need Kitchen help by 4p & serving help at 5 or 5:30p, clean up help after the event and of course we'll need sides and desserts. No one will need to work during the meal. [I'll be at the church by 3 or even earlier and have the warming ovens on (warming, not cooking)]. No door prizes, just dinner (Is that Correct??) [The OctoberFEST Poster and RSVP list is out. [This will be the November and December key Agenda Item.]
