ST. THERESE HAITI TWINNING MISSION UPDATE

To date, St. Therese has sent Fr. Richardson \$4,000.00 (equal to approximately \$540,000.00 Haitian dollars) to support the salaries of the elementary school teachers and staff. The committee's goal is to send Fr. Richardson \$12,000.00 per year; \$4,000.00 every March, July, and November. Our first order of bricks has arrived to the church. The second order of bricks has been placed and will arrive soon. To date, our parishioners have purchased approximately 35 bricks. We are truly blessed! Bricks will be set in the garden area to the left of the front entrance.

Engraved bricks will make great Christmas presents. Although the bricks will not arrive in time for Christmas, we will give you a card with a picture of your engraved brick to wrap.




