CALLING ALL PARISHIONERS TO SERVE IN LITURGICAL MINISTRIES!

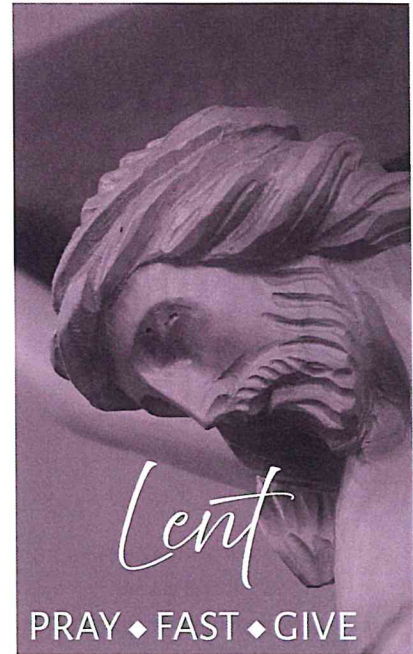

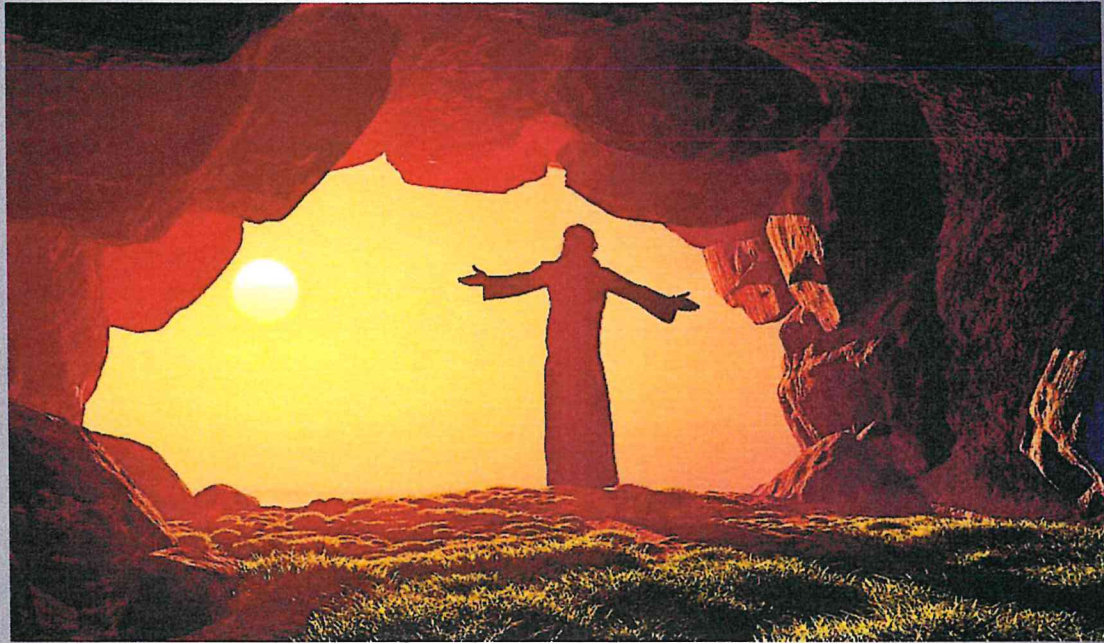

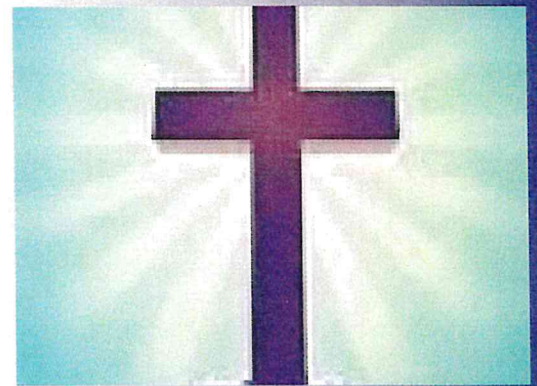
