Pilgrimage

Bishop Knestout celebrated the opening of the Jubilee Year door in the diocesan Cathedral, Sacred Heart, in Richmond in December. As pilgrims we can experience walking through the doors and receive plenary indulgences and special graces. There are four conditions for receiving an indulgence;

- 1)True repentance and freedom from any affection for sin
- 2)Go to Confession (if possible on the day of the visit or within a week)
- 3) Receive Communion (the same day as the visit)
- 4) Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.

A Jubilee Pilgrimage is an opportunity for all Catholics to participate in a spiritual work of mercy of our Church. We can and should pray for our loved ones who may be away from the sacraments. We must pray for our loved ones who have gone before us in the sign of faith. We can pray for any and all needs that we hold in our hearts.

We will leave the church parking lot at 9:00 am and return by 4:00 pm. Once we arrive in Richmond, we will be taken on a tour of the museum and crypt as well as a demonstration of the organ. There is a small gift shop that will be opened also. Lunch will be BYO brown bag and we will eat in the Cathedral parish hall.
